Day Two of the NSS Special Camp began with the Morning Prayer where the members of **House Yodha** sang the Prayer followed by other Volunteers. The morning session was conducted by Volunteer Muskan Thakur. After completing the routine morning protocol, the volunteers set out Shrenni village which was adopted for undertaking community work and sensitizing villagers about cleanliness. The volunteers identified the problems of village Shrenni by interaction with the people of that village. The main problems which identified by the volunteers were non-cleanliness of the pedestrian, throwing of the waste materials, non cleanliness of water resources and disposed off bio-degradable and non-degradable waste in an environmental friendly manner. The volunteers then returned to the campus and assembled for lunch. After the lunch was over, they were asked to assemble in the college hall for post lunch session. In the post lunch session the NSS Programme Officer Dr. Susheel Kumar gave a power point presentation on the topic 'Sustainable Development'. He apprised the volunteers to adopt the way of life in the manner of environment friendly. The session concluded with the singing of National Anthem.



On Day 3 all the volunteers of the Special Camp assembled in the college ground for Morning Prayer, NSS song, two-minute silence and discussion on the thought for the day. The morning session was conducted by **House Samparan**. The volunteers then set out toward the adopted village Shrenni. The volunteers picked garbage and plastic waste material on the passage Shrenni village starting from Koti bazar. The volunteer collected about 50 kilograms of scrap and placed it in the village garbage box and burned it. The volunteers then came back to college for lunch. After the lunch all the volunteers assembled in the college hall for the post lunch session. In the session the Prof. Sh. Vishal Rangta delivered a lecture on 'The Importance of Cleanliness in day to day life'. Then the volunteers were engaged in rehearsing cultural items and report writing. Post the singing of the National Anthem the volunteers left for their respective places.


