

Educational Tour to Shimla
Organized by Road Safety Club, GDC Chail Koti

The Road Safety Club of Government Degree College (GDC) Chail Koti organized an educational tour to Shimla on 10 March 2026 under the convenorship of Prof. Devender Singh. The primary objective of the tour was to provide practical exposure to the volunteers regarding traffic management, road safety practices, and the role of law enforcement agencies in maintaining smooth traffic flow.

A total of 22 volunteers from the Road Safety Club participated in the tour. During the visit, the students observed major traffic congestion hotspots of Shimla, particularly Dhalli and Sanjauli Chowks, which experience heavy traffic flow during peak hours. The visit provided the students with a real-life understanding of traffic conditions and the challenges faced in managing traffic in busy urban areas.

At these locations, duty police officers interacted with the students and explained various traffic rules, regulations, and safety measures that must be followed by both drivers and pedestrians. The officers also emphasized the importance of public awareness and responsible behavior on roads in order to reduce accidents and traffic congestion.

Various issues related to road safety were discussed during the interaction. The students actively participated in the session and asked several questions regarding traffic control, accident prevention, and the responsibilities of road users. The police officials addressed their queries in a very informative and positive manner.

The practical observation of traffic movement along with direct interaction with police personnel proved to be a unique and innovative learning experience for the students. The activity helped the volunteers understand the significance of road safety and encouraged them to promote awareness about traffic rules in society.

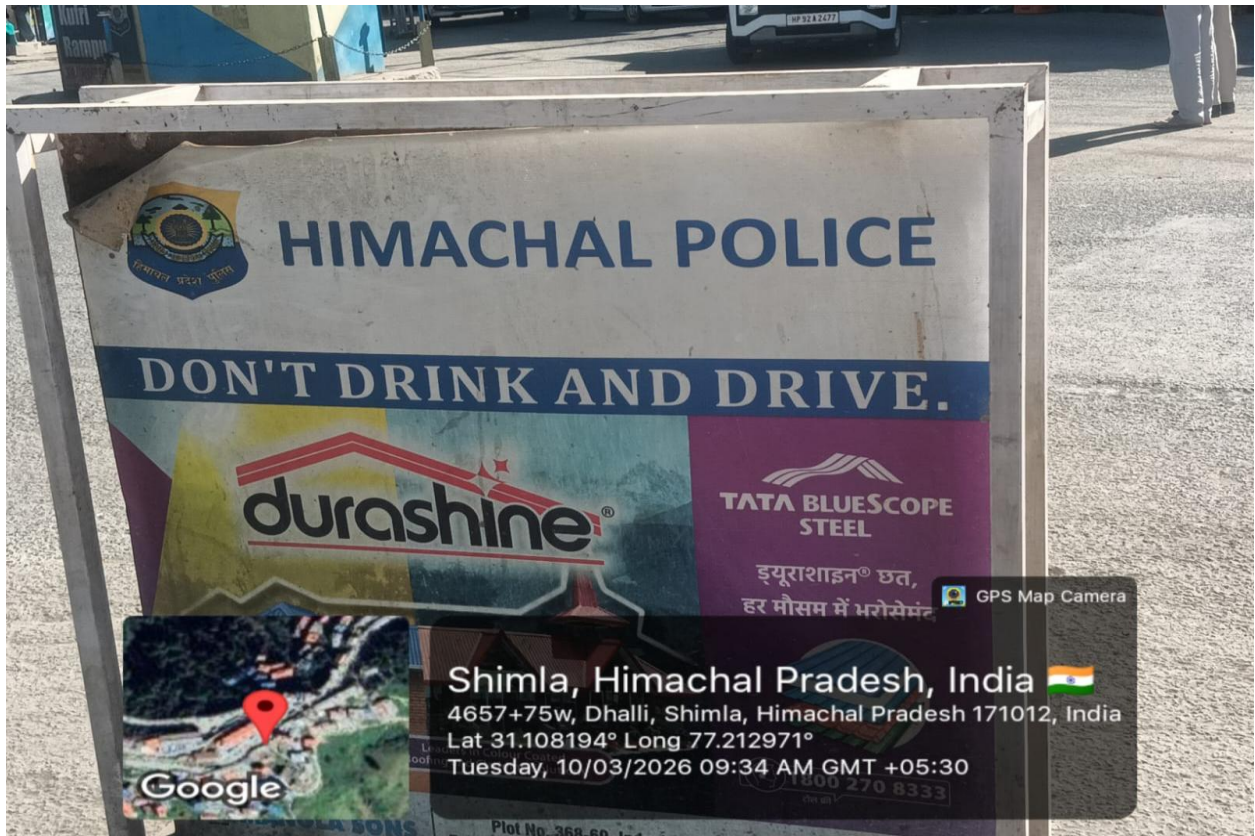
